

# Civil Society Responses to the OHCHR report on Sri Lanka

**Introduction:** On 16<sup>th</sup> September, the High Commissioner for Human Rights presented a report which investigated allegations of human rights violations and serious crimes committed in Sri Lanka during the period of 2002 – 2011. The report provides specific recommendations to the Government of Sri Lanka and the international community for genuine transitional processes.

This unique opportunity will take the form of open panel discussion with Sri Lankan civil society representatives from different ethnic and religious communities. They will share their responses to the report and discuss steps need to be taken for truth, justice, accountability and reconciliation in the country.
